2021 Banquet Dress Code Policy

The following dress code is for any student attending the banquet (Takoma Academy or Students from other schools). For special programs held on or off campus sponsored by or in the name of Takoma Academy including Banquets and the like, the following dress code must be followed:

- Dress should be appropriate to suit the event and conform to the guidelines and in good taste.
- Good taste includes the following
 - o Females (Dresses must be pre approved by Mrs. Thrower, April 13-May 19. Please send a picture of the dress for approval to Mrs. Thrower....cthrower@ta.edu)
 - no plunging necklines
 - no undergarments visible between tops and bottoms of an outfit
 - no back cut out may go below the hip
 - no keyhole from the top to the bottom of the breast line
 - short dresses are to be no shorter than the mid thigh
 - Sheer material must follow the same guidelines as if there were no material
 - No belly button or mid-drift may be visible
 - No slits in dresses can be higher than mid thigh
 - o Males
 - All men must wear appropriate dress wear (i.e. Tuxedo, Suit, Dress pants with sports blazer etc)
 - No short pants
 - Men's shirts must stay on at all times.
